Elections 2022

It's hard to believe, but in fact it has been 2 years since Corvettes of Durham held elections for our executive positions. The last vote was held in October 2020 during the lockdown. This was followed by a mini election in April 2021 to fill vacant positions.

Elections take place during our Annual General Meeting, which is held in October. Our next Annual General Meeting will take place on **October 19, 2022.**

We have 4 elected executive positions as follows:

President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary

Members are voted into their positions for a term of 2 years.

Qualifications

To run for one of the Executive Officer positions, you must be a member of Corvettes of Durham Social Club for a minimum of 2 years.

Nominations

Nominations for Executive Officer positions shall be held at the monthly General Meeting held in September. Our Constitution and By-Laws allows for nominations to be submitted by mail or email.

All nominations must be seconded in order to be valid.

Voting

The selection of the Executive Officers shall be determined by majority vote through elections held at the Annual General Meeting on October 19th. The largest number of votes determines the election of the candidate.

Our Constitution and By-Laws allows for proxy voting, as well as in-person voting. The proxy vote must be signed by the club member submitting the vote and must be presented at the Annual General Meeting.

The current members of the Executive Committee will ensure everyone has an opportunity to vote.

2022 Corvette Final Production Statistics




Final production statistics for the 2022 Corvette are now available for viewing. Of the 25,831 cars produced, 52.1% were coupes, while convertibles came in just under the halfway split at 47.9%. Torch Red was once again the most popular color choice for 2022. The complete color lineup is as follows:

2023 Z06 Canadian Pricing



GM announced U.S. pricing for the <u>2023 Corvette Z06</u> last week, confirming the mid-engine supercar will hit the market with an approachable <u>starting price of \$106,395</u>. The automaker has now also confirmed Canadian pricing for the vehicle, with <u>Chevy</u> fans north of the border facing a slightly higher starting price of just over C\$128,000.


Canadian pricing for the 2023 <u>Corvette</u> Z06 Coupe in the entry-level 1LZ trim will start at C\$128,198, including the mandatory destination freight charge. Pricing for the Coupe in the 2LZ trim, meanwhile, will start at \$138,198, while the Coupe in the range-topping 3LZ trim will start at \$144,198.




