



MHPYC Prospective Member Application Process

Thank you for your interest in the Mariposa Hunters Point Yacht Club (MHPYC). This sheet explains the membership process for our club. If you have any questions, please feel free to email us at mhpycmembership@gmail.com.

All Prospective Members must be sponsored by a member of the MHPYC. Your sponsor must be a member of the club for at least one year to sponsor a Prospective Member (PM). You and your sponsor will complete the Application for Prospective Membership Introduction. The completed form is then emailed to mhpycmembership@gmail.com or dropped off at the club for the Membership Committee's review. Once your application is received, the Membership Committee will contact you and your sponsor for an interview over the phone.

If your application is accepted, you and your sponsor will co-ordinate with our Membership Committee to set up a date when you can be introduced to our membership at one of our General Meetings. General Meetings are held every month except for January on the second Saturday of the month at 6:30 PM. Please **arrive at least 30 minutes early to check in**. You will have four General Meeting cycles from the date we accept your application to attend a General Meeting with your sponsor for an introduction to the membership. **Please do NOT turn in this application if you cannot make a General Meeting within four meetings WITH your sponsor (it is required your sponsor is present)**. If you sponsor remits the application and you fail to attend with in four meetings you will have to wait twelve months to re-apply. If an unforeseen emergency happens you may have your sponsor contact the Membership Committee and we will happily apply to the board for an extension.

At our General Meeting the board will have sponsors introduce their PM's. You will then go before our board and our general membership. Your sponsor will tell the members who you are, how they know you and why they feel you would be an asset to our club. You will then tell members a little bit about yourself (line of work, where you are from, reasons for wanting to be a member of the club, etc.). The floor is then opened for members and the board to ask questions.

Please arrive at the meeting by 6pm and check in with the Membership Committee. At this time, you will pay the \$150 application processing fee and receive your Prospective Membership Card. The Prospective Membership Card allows you access to the club without your sponsor being present. On the back of the card there is space for officers of the club to sign. You are required to have this card signed three times by an officer of the club before you can be sworn in as a member. You may have your card signed off once for simply attending any of our club sponsored events. Two of the three signatures must be for volunteering (cooking, workdays, etc.). Please note, the person working behind the bar may sign off your card as they are considered "Officer of the Day". You have up to six months to complete your probation but may complete it in as little as three. The probationary period is a minimum of three months and a maximum of six months.

When you have passed the probationary period of at least three months and have three signatures on your PM card you may contact the Membership Committee and let them know you have completed your probation. If you do not have your PM card completed within six months your PM status will be revoked and the \$150 application fee is forfeited. Again, if an unforeseen emergency happens please contact the Membership Committee and they will happily request and extension from the board. The committee will then submit your completed application to the board for consideration. If your application is approved, the Membership Committee will contact you and you can be sworn at the next General Meeting. **The day you are sworn in you are required to pay prorated annual dues. The schedule of these dues is located on the Prospective Member Information Form.** If your application is denied you will be refunded your application fee of \$150.

Bartenders may close earlier or stay open later than published hours, depending on the number of members present. The Club will be open at 10:00am for scheduled Sunday Brunch.

The Club will be open approximately 1.5 hours before game time both during the week and on the weekend. Any changes will be communicated via email. Please check website calendar for early opening days; otherwise all other home games are within our regularly scheduled operating hours and will not be noted on the website. At bartender discretion, the Club will be open at least one hour after every game.



General Meetings- are held the second Saturday of every month (Except for January, there is no General Meeting that month) at 6:30 PM.

Dues/Pro-Rated Dues: Annual dues are \$250 per year per member. Annual dues are due on January 1. *If dues are not received by February 15*, your membership will be suspended. If you wish to be reinstated to the club at that *time you also must pay the reinstatement fee (currently \$75)* as well as your annual dues of \$250. A suspended member that has not been reinstate by June 30th shall be deemed to have resigned from the club and their membership will be permanently cancelled. **If you are a new member you will pay prorated dues according the month you are sworn in as member.** The pro-rated dues are due the day you are sworn in before the meeting begins. The schedule for new member prorated dues is as follows:

PM Eligibility Events- Once you are introduced to membership you will be given a Prospective Membership Card. In order to be eligible for membership you must have the card signed off by attending or volunteering at the club. The card can be signed off by an officer of the club (please note that Bartenders are the officers of the day). The following is a list of opportunities to have your card signed off:

You must have your card signed off at least **twice for events that are in service of the club:**

Attendance at: (You may only have one sign off of this type)

- General Meetings – AFTER your introduction
- Club Sponsored Events
- Sunday Brunches
- Cruise Outs

Volunteer for Shift*: – defined by the Event Sponsor: (You must have two sign offs of this type)

- Cook in Galley
- Work Days
- Special Events

MHPYC Rules of Conduct

As a PM of the MHPYC you must follow the rules of the club and conduct yourself accordingly.

- 1) When you enter the club, you must sign the book. You will sign in as a Prospective Member.
- 2) You must wear a name tag when you are in the club. Under sponsor you will write Prospective Member.
- 3) You will not divulge the club's business to any outsider.
- 4) You must be respectful to all members and their guests.
- 5) Please be aware when children attend the club and act accordingly. This is a club which includes families not a private bar please be mindful of using offensive language.
- 6) No fighting, or threatening members or their guests.
- 7) Members often host private parties at our club, you can attend the club during a private party but do NOT help yourself to food or beverages purchased by the host unless you are invited by them to do so. (Please note you may not host a party until you are a full pledged member of the MHPYC)
- 8) As a Prospective Member of the club you are limited to bringing in guests who are members of your immediate family only.
