

<u>**Relief</u>**—On Oct 28th & 29th there will be a second collection for Relief to people in Puerto Rico and those suffering in Mexico from the earthquake. The donations collected will be divided between the two causes. Both of these areas are devastated and are in much need of aid.</u>

St. Augustin-Our Twin Parish: In "The Word Among Us" we are reminded of the three paths to spiritual growth, Prayer, Fasting, and Alms-giving. Your Justice and Peace Committee is asking all parishioners and visitors to walk with them in lifting up our Twin Parish, St. Augustin, Island of LaGonave, village of Gros Mangle, Haiti. Your prayers and fasting can change lives, theirs and yours. As to alms-giving, we are starting a sponsorship program for students, teachers, and lunch meal program for the St. Augustin School. Student sponsorship is \$300.00 per year with monies applied to tuition, uniform, and a small stipend to their families. Teacher sponsorship is offered tat \$1,000.00 per year. This is about one years salary. Lunch meal program sponsorship is \$30.00, the cost of providing one days lunch for all the children. In addition a separate Family Sponsorship program is offered at \$300.00 per year.
