Treasurer report: Current Balance \$23,400.37

CIFL is a name on our checking account so John will be going to bank to open a new checking account and get new checks since we do not know where the remaining checks are. A new signature card will need to be signed by the 4 board members.

Special Committees:

- Cash bash will be Oct. 22 and Darcy working on DJ or Band.
- 30 Day Email fundraiser will be during the month of June with ticket hand out during April 3<sup>rd</sup> registration. \$10 per ticket and each child will be given 10; additional children in the family will receive 5 tickets each. 1<sup>st</sup> place seller will receive a \$100 Dick's card, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$75, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$50. Every 10 tickets sold will count as 1 volunteer time for the parent/guardian. We will need to sell 400 tickets to break even. Darcy getting tickets from Donnell's
- Garage sale will be April 30 in Fairbury at Darcy's house. All extra items will be sent to Laura Erickson's house for the Chenoa garage sale the following week. Darcy put info on Facebook with drop off locations. People can also drop them off the day of registration.

- Trailers for inventory will need to be gone through and this is scheduled for April 2 at 11:00 at Jason's new shop in Chenoa. More members we have the faster this will go.

Old Business:

- Payment of One call is on hold. Some thought \$459.00 to renew could be avoided if we looked into doing a TEXT app instead. Dana will call for an extension but will need to be voted on at the April meeting. Looking at Team Snap and Reminder
- Registration will be April 3 from 1-5 at the Country Club. Dana will work on communication with paper, car wash sign, FB page, and schools. \$150 for football, \$75 for Cheer (increase due to warm ups being purchased), and \$40 for Flag. Additional \$50 will be added (including Flag) for volunteer fees and cashed per child. Dana has ordered new form and will have all the registration forms for sign-up.

Other business:

- Volunteering: This was a lengthy discussion by all. Stacie and Darcy feel like they would like to reach out to PC organizations to see if they would like to donate their time and run the concession stand for all PC Youth games. We would in return pay them a donation fee towards their organization. They will report back at the next meeting to see if any organizations would be interested. There are some concerns that parents will not have enough slots to fill their volunteer obligation especially since we are including Flag parents this year. For those parents/guardians that do not volunteer this is a profit for our organization and not sure we can afford to lose.
