

San Jose Sightseeing City Tour



This tour immerses you in the rich Costa Rican culture and history by experiencing the beautiful museums and historical sites of San José. A drive through the beautiful Sabana Park, the historic National Theatre. Completed in 1897, the theatre is a masterpiece in art and architecture. A visit from one to many unique sight of Costa Rica.

Harbouring hidden corners with a half-day city tour of San José provides a good welcome or farewell to Costa Rica's history and culture. See examples of neoclassical architecture that provides a testament to the country's coffee culture and tour an old fortress with one of the best views of the capital city.



San Jose is a city that can be seen better by walking some streets and avenues. Despite being underestimated by its small size, this city is full of characters, where the Josefinos (adjective given to its inhabitants) are known to be simple people, enterprising, "pulseadora" without hesitation to give a smile to strangers. Be amazed by the architectural beauty of the most emblematic of the city, its pleasant parks robust cooling shade trees and fascinating cultural history told through neighbourhoods, beautiful buildings and monuments. A brief stop will be made in a beautiful art craft shopping store allowing you to browse through it before returning home and why not, buy some souvenirs for those who are expecting you back at home.

Half day Grecia - Sarchi



Our first stop is the town of Grecia, home to one of the only Metal Churches in Central America, this quiet town is an official stop for tourists heading to the famous town of Sarchi. Our next stop along the way is the enchanting village of Sarchí, many houses are adorned with colourful gingerbread trim – just one example of the craftsmanship in wood for which this little town is famous. With its pink church, trimmed in pale green, Sarchi is truly a fairy tale town. Known as the cradle of Costa Rican artisans. Here we will take in the artistic work of the local artisans, as they create the famous typical oxcarts.

In the numerous souvenir shops, visitors find an astounding array of crafts and other wooden products, as well as items in cloth, glass, bronze and other materials, making gift choices a delightful challenge. It is here, in Sarchi, where you will see craftsmen meticulously hand-painting the colorful ox-carts and oxcart wheels that you may have seen elsewhere in Costa Rica. Doka Coffee Plantation - Grecia - Sarchi

The Doka Coffee Tour takes you through a real working gourmet coffee plantation - you will see three generations of coffee tradition. The main objective of the Coffee Tour is to educate and inform tourists about the process that growing coffee involves. The tour guides are very knowledgeable and full of information that will make the tour a special learning experience. You will hear about the history of the coffee farm, its owners; it's geographic location, the traditional coffee growing methods, and also the coffee brewing tradition of 'chorrear'. The tour takes you to Almacigo, your first stop, where the process of growing and producing fine coffee is covered from planting the seed to picking the ripened coffee berries. From here you will visit the 'recibidor' (coffee bean receiver) where you will be shown the first classification of the coffee beans as well as the different brands that are processed on the estate. The oldest working water powered mill in the country (beneficio) is the next stop. You will see the peeling machines, how they work and what we do with the coffee bean skins. The fermentation tanks and their importance in the resulting taste of the coffee, follows. The bodega is where they store the coffee and where export ready coffee is kept. You will also visit the sun drying patios and the roasting hall where you will see and smell the different roasts produced.

Irazú Volcano National Park



Located on the province of Cartago at the east of the country, it was the first established capital, so it has history, architecture and culture to offer to the visitors. A must here, is a visit to the catholic shrine of the Lady of the Angels, the patron of Costa Rica, believed to have saved or cured miraculously many people. Full of legends and traditions, Cartago is also surrounded by mountains of fertile soil that create beautiful, colorful landscapes, topped by the colossal Irazú volcano, the highest of the

country.

Just an hour and 30 minutes' to 2 hours drive from San José, Irazú Volcano National Park has Costa Rica's highest volcano at 3,432 meters (11,260 feet) above sea level, and offers visitors the chance to glimpse stark and dramatic lunar landscape with vegetation that is only beginning to come back after the last violent period of activity, from 1962-65. The route to Irazú passes through one of the country's most fertile agricultural areas, where almost all of Costa Rica's onions, potatoes and carrots are grown. Further up the slope, verdant pastures support herds of dairy cattle. A paved road leads right to the top of Irazú, within a few hundred feet of the principal crater with a chartreuse colored sulphur lake at its center.

At a La Paz Water Falls Gardens you will enjoy a special visit to the Gardens where you can access Niagara Falls our paths through professionally designed and sighting platforms. Park is located in the mountains cloud with a temperature suitable for the cool hikes. Conclude with a visit to the butterfly and admire the natural beauty surrounding the Falls Gardens, then activities continues to your next attraction.
