TECHNIQUE OF THE MONTH: ORANGE BELT - SIMITAR

From A Right Punch

1S - Left Foot Step To 11:00

1S - Left Inward Block To Outside Of The Right Punch

1S - Right Arm Cocked High to rear at 7;30

2S - Right CCW slicing back knuckle through right rib cage

2S - Left hand to cover

3 - Right back-fist strikes CW through the kidney
