April 22 - Meeting with the BRIDGE program students to introduce school farm concept

April 24 - Serving food at the Culinary Art Show out at Ready Randy's

<u>April 26 -</u> Cool class dissection of a pregnant shark (pregnant with triplets!), two goat kids, and our unhatched incubator eggs.

<u>April 29 -</u> Dr. Jeff Johnson from the WITC-Rice Lake campus came to do labs with my animal science students - splinting, suturing, repro system identification, ruminant stomach parts and functions - Is one of the interested WITC staff members who want to partner to increase opportunities for NRHS students
