Adopted March 31, 2014

Members The Greater Dayton Realist Foundation Board of Trustees shall not benefit from any programs, grants, gifts, materials, or collaborations the GDRF, Inc. operates or affiliates.

Members of The Greater Dayton Realist Foundation Board of Trustees shall not accept gifts, payments or gratuities in exchange for programming rights from individuals, suppliers, companies or clients, which might benefit in return from program affiliation.

The Greater Dayton Realist Foundation does not make contracts with any active board members for professional services without the approval of the board and an appropriate investigation of the due diligence done in requesting the contract ensues in order to ensure there is no conflict of interest.

If a conflict of interest happens, the board can use sanctions and or dismissal as a means of discipline.

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
