

A Pet Friendly Tip: Here's a few tips on keeping your car's litter box fresh: Clean your litter box weekly. To clean it, put on rubber gloves and put the entire litter box in a trash bag. Holding bag upright, shake litter into the bag and remove the litter box. Use pre-moistened wipes to wipe out the

box. Be sure not to use wipes with bleach in them. Line the litterbox with newspaper and sprinkle with baking soda. This will make it easier to clean next time. Pour new litter on top of baking soda and you're all set!
