## IN A HURRY

"I'm in a hurry to get things done; I rush and rush until life's no fun" I'm in a Hurry – Alabama 1992

Nick Saban coaches Alabama – the Crimson Tide not the old country music boys from Fort Payne – but you know he probably hums that tune on his way to the practice field.

A whole bunch of college football teams are hurrying to get things done on offense, and the no-huddle, up-tempo, NASCAR-fast attack is making life no fun for defensive wizards like Saban. While casual fans might envision hurry up offenses as throwing the ball all over the field, the most successful such teams do like the song says. They rush and rush (run the football!) until life is no fun for the defense.

Welcome back to The Blitz for week two of the college football season. You can find all you need to know about this week's game as quick as it takes Oregon or Auburn to run another play.

The Ducks and the Tigers are poster teams for hurry up offenses. After each play, they hustle to the line, read the defense, and snap. Part of the strategy of the up-tempo attack is certainly to snap the ball quickly and often. Doing so limits to an extent the amount of substitutions a defense can make (Saban, for instance, loves to substitute by situation), and it tires them out because it is difficult to simulate such pace in practice.

However, at its core the hurry up is based on perhaps the most old-fashioned principle in football – run the ball up the gut. It is simply a numbers game. The offense spreads the field by sending backs and receivers wide, forcing the defense to commit a certain number of players to "the box" (area near the line of scrimmage) and to the secondary. If the number of defenders in the box is equal to or less than the number of offensive linemen (guards, tackles, and tight ends), expect a dive option up the middle. If the box defenders flow toward the running back, the quarterback simply pulls the ball and runs wide. Using that simple strategy last year, Auburn RB Tre Mason gashed opponents for more than 1,800 yards and scored 23 touchdowns, while his QB Nick Marshall sprinted for over 1,000 yards and ran for 12 TDs.

By the way, the Tigers beat the team coached by a fellow named Saban.

This week's top game (see Game of the Week column) features a terrific matchup of hurry-up flash (Oregon) hosting slow-down smash (Michigan State). Regardless of who wins that game, a lot of college football teams are in a hurry to get things done, and they are making life no fun for defenses.

### AROUND THE NATION

The main Thursday night game features a Big East ... oh, wait a minute ... an ACC pairing of Pittsburgh (1-0) at Boston College (1-0) In Big Ten country, the Ohio State Buckeyes (1-0) welcome Beamer's Boys from Virginia Tech (1-0) to the Horseshoe along the banks of the Olentangy. That is worth a look, as is the last Michigan (1-0)-Notre Dame (1-0) game for a while. The Wolverines travel to the Irish. Out West, Saturday offers up PAC-12 contenders battling in Palo Alto when USC (1-0) takes on Stanford (1-0) in the first big test for new Trojan head coach Steve Sarkisian. The premier tilt in the Southwest features BYU (1-0) traveling to the Lone Star state to tangle with Texas (1-0). Finally, SEC pickings are mighty slim, but how about the debut of Kenny Hill for Texas A&M!

### GAME-OF-THE-WEEK



#### MICHIGAN STATE AT OREGON



When Michigan State (1-0) travels to Eugene to take on the Oregon Ducks (1-0), it could easily be an early "impressive win for the resume" game that the College Football Playoff selection committee will weigh heavily in early December when they are evaluating teams, so it's a very important game for both the Spartans and the Ducks.

QB's Marcus Mariota and Connor Cook are keys to this game. The QB that makes the fewest mistakes will probably be the one who walks away with the victory. Mariota has been a Heisman Trophy candidate for two years and he is poised to have a huge season if he can just stay healthy. He has passed for 63 touchdowns with just 10 interceptions in his career at Oregon, plus he has rushed for over 1,500 yards which makes him very difficult to defend. Connor Cook is 13-1 as a starter and has come up big in the high profile games for Michigan State. He passed for 304 yards in the Big Ten Championship game against Ohio State and 334 yards in the Rose Bowl vs Stanford.

The all-time series is tied 2-2. MSU beat Oregon in East Lansing in 1979 and 1999, while the Ducks beat the Spartans in Eugene in 1980 and 1998.

There is a reason, THE BLITZ has Oregon ranked #1. We believe Oregon will win every game and playing Michigan State at Autzen Stadium will prove too difficult for the Spartans. Oregon wins this game but MSU will prove to be a worthy opponent.

#### 1998: FLORIDA STATE, KANSAS STATE OR OHIO STATE?

Below we question whether the BCS selected the correct team to face Tennessee in the very first BCS Championship Game in the Fiesta Bowl in Tempe, Arizona.

How different would history have been had Ohio State been in Tempe, Arizona to play Tennessee in the very first BCS Championship Game? Would John Cooper have been retained beyond 2000? Would Jim Tressel have ever been Ohio State's coach or would he have been hired by another school in 2001? What about Kansas State? Bill Snyder's team led by QB Michael Bishop was so dominate during the 1998 season. The Wildcats were virtually booking hotel reservations in Arizona to face the Volunteers when they were upset in double overtime by a gutsy Texas A&M squad. We'll never know because Florida State was #2 in the final 1998 BCS Standings. Kansas State ended up #3 in the final BCS Standings and Ohio State was #4.

Tennessee was the clear #1 team after going 11-0 in the regular season including a miracle win over Arkansas at Neyland Stadium when the Razorback's QB Clint Stoerner inexplicably fumbled the ball away allowing the Vols an opportunity to pounce on it and drive down for the winning score at the end of the game. That propelled Tennessee to the SEC Championship Game where they beat Mississippi State 24-14.

In 1998 the Big Ten and Big 12 were very strong conferences. The Big Ten finished with a 30-12 .714 record vs non-conference opponents including a perfect 5-0 in bowl games. The final AP Poll had 5 Big Ten teams in the Top 25. The Big 12 Conference was 33-12 .733, went 3-4 in bowl games and also had 5 schools ranked in the final AP Poll. By contrast the ACC was 21-12 636 vs non-conference opponents, went 2-3 in bowl games and had 3 schools appear in the final AP Poll.

Based on the resumes and conference strengths did Florida State deserve to be the opponent in the Fiesta Bowl to play Tennessee? Even though it can not be figured into any data base, Florida State lost starting QB Chris Weinke in their final ACC game and were required to start their 3rd string QB, Marcus Outzen vs Tennessee.

Florida State lost their 1 game at NC State by 17 points (24-7). Kansas State lost their 1 game at a neutral site by 3 points in double overtime to Texas A&M (36-33). Ohio State lost their 1 game at home vs Michigan State by 4 points (28-24). Florida State lost in mid-September, Ohio State lost in early November and Kansas State lost in the Big 12 Championship Game in early December.

Did the BCS get it right in 1998? It is definitely debatable. Below are the schedules.
