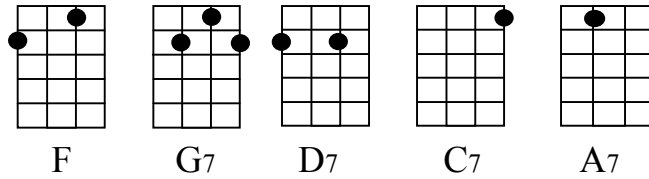


My Little Grass Shack in Kealakekua, Hawai'i
