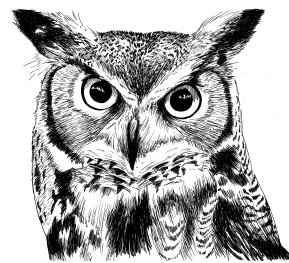


OYO Camp
