

New Vienna City Council Meeting
March 15,2018

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the special meeting at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, Jim Naber, Mike Leuchs and T.J.Kloser.

Leuchs made the motion to approve the agenda for March 15,2018 seconded by Naber.

The purpose of this special meeting that was called by Brian and Angie Kronlage and the New Vienna Athletic Assoc. was to discuss the bathroom project at the ballpark and to finalize the financial responsibilities between the city and the athletic assoc. for this project.

Members present from the Association were: Brian And Angie Kronlage, Brad Koopman, Denise Bollweg, Kim Krapfl.

Brian Kronalge addressed the council and stated that the athletic association was under the impression that the City of New Vienna was going to be paying \$12,000.00 towards this project and they have already started the work and needed to know if they would be able to proceed. The Mayor and council stated that they had made a motion to have the association proceed with this project but had not agreed to cover all the cost involved, due to the fact that we did not budget for this in our park fund and did not have those funds available. Angie Kronalge stated that they had received two grants already for a total of \$4500.00 to go towards this project and that would leave roughly around \$6000.00 that they were looking at the City to fund. Discussion followed as the council had many questions as did the Athletic Association on this project. The council stated that all invoices are to go through the city books as is all grant funding for the bathroom project. The Mayor stated that all changes to project need to be brought to the council as this is City property. The Athletic Association agreed to the stipulations and financial contribution from the City. Kloser made the motion for the City of New Vienna to pay up to \$5500.00 max on this project, second by Naber. Ayes-all.
