Let us lift our hearts and voices in unity to God, with praises in our mouths and thanksgiving in our hearts.


Lord, your power is visible in all of creation and your existence is too magnificent and marvelous for us to comprehend.




THE AFFIRMATION OF FAITH



Almighty God, please forgive my sins and deliver me from evil. In the mighty and holy name of the Lord Jesus Christ, I pray, Amen.




