

Evangelism/Outreach Team Description and Purpose

First Baptist Church, Los Alamos, New Mexico

Purpose:

The Evangelism/Outreach Team organizes and assists members of the church to reach out with God's grace and to present the Gospel to the lost of Los Alamos, New Mexico, the United States, and the world, seeking to bring them to a saving knowledge of Christ. The Team also supports people who are sent to share the Gospel.

Membership:

The Team leader is elected by the congregation and operates under the supervision of the ministerial staff. The Team is staffed through requests for participation and volunteer commitments.

Organization:

Individuals or small groups within the Team plan, organize, and carry out specific activities within the Team's areas of responsibility. The Team may further organize itself as it sees fit to accomplish its purpose.

Areas of Responsibility:

- Creating an awareness of the church's missions responsibilities
- Leading the church in mission endeavors
- Promoting prayer for missions
- Leading in programs designed to reach our community for Christ

Duties:

- The Evangelism Team leader is a member of the Church Council and will attend the meetings or designate another Team member to attend.
- All Team members will assist the Team leader in preparing a budget request to submit to the Finance Committee.
- The Team will plan, promote and implement programs that enlist and train members of the church in witnessing and community outreach programs.
- The Team will plan and promote church-wide evangelistic efforts, e.g., missions education, missionary visits, campaigns for fund raising for the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering, the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, Harry P. Stagg State Mission Offering, mission projects beyond the local area, etc.
- The Team will promote and assist in implementing outreach and witnessing efforts in all the organizations of the church.
- The Team will identify local mission needs and develop and implement plans to meet these needs.
- The Team will review this Ministry Statement periodically and revise and update it as needed and present changes to the congregation for approval.
- The Team will review relevant church policies periodically and recommend revisions and updates to the congregation for approval.
