Re: Precautionary Suspension Credentials Committee Review

Dear Dr. Dinsmore:

Please be advised that the Credentials Committee has been appointed to review certain information regarding the review of 13 separate cases, some of which have been reviewed by outside experts. This review will coincide with a review of your application for reappointment and elevation which is currently pending. Of the cases identified for review, several are still pending outside examination. It is anticipated that review of these cases will take at least another 14 days, and we will be working with the hospital administration and the outside reviewer to expedite the review and meet as soon as possible to consider all the cases. We will advise you immediately as soon as the cases are returned and we can schedule another meeting.

Prior to this review, you will be provided notice and provided an opportunity to review all cases that have been examined. Under the provisions of our Credentialing Policy Manual, you will be invited to meet with the Credentials Committee, should you wish to do so, to discuss the matters under review and to provide any additional information to the Committee regarding your application for reappointment.
