### **April Meeting**

### Fluke Regulations

There has been a slight change in the fluke regulations for 2014. At this time the season will open on May 17 and close on September 21. There will be a bag limit of 5 fish at a minimum length of 18 inches.

### Winter Flounder

Winter flounder season opens on April 1, 2014. The minimum size for flounder is 12 inches with a 2 fish limit.

### **Bass Season**

At this time it looks like bass season will start on April 15, 2014. The limits are the same as 2013. This is subject to change by the DEC before the season begins, so be sure to check the DEC web site <a href="https://www.dec.ny.gov">www.dec.ny.gov</a> for any change.

### **Fishing Registry**

Before you drop that fishing line is the water be sure to register with the DEC. The registry is free but required before you go fishing. Go to the following link <a href="http://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/54950.html">http://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/54950.html</a>, follow the instructions and register.
