RESOLUTION DECLINING REQUEST TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE SANITARY SEWERAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM

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WHEREAS, David P. Fraser, on behalf of CTP Naples Investments, LLC., (CPT) and/or other individuals or entities with an interest in the vacant parcels on Pug Road in St. Clair Township, bearing parcel identification numbers 74-30-039-1012-000, 74-30-039-1012-001, and 74-30-039-1012-010, (the Premises) has proposed the construction of a new Private Sanitary Sewerage Collection System to serve said Premises and/or other parcels as noted in Correspondence dated February 19, 2021, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the St. Clair Township Board has considered the request and finds that it is not in the best interest of the residents of the St. Clair Township to agree to assume such responsibilities should the developer and/or private owner become insolvent or unable to continue system operation.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. CPT and any other party or entity with interest in installing a Private Sanitary Sewerage Collection System on the Premises must obtain all state and local permits necessary to construct said Private Sanitary Sewerage Collection System, and any appurtenances associated therewith at their own cost and file copies of the same with the Township;
- 2. St. Clair Township <u>shall not</u>, under any circumstances, agree to become responsible in any manner for the operation and maintenance of any such Private Sanitary Sewerage Collection System, regardless of whether the developer or owners become insolvent or otherwise unable to continue system operation; and

CPT and any other party or entity with interest in proposed development of the Premises and installing a Private Sanitary Sewerage Collection System must comply with the requirements of The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Water Resource Division Policy and Procedure Part 41 for sewerage system permit approval by establishing a perpetual funding mechanism as outlined therein and comply with all other requirements, thereof

This Addendum shall serve as an amendment to the existing St. Clair County RESA's Information Technology Services Agreement with the St. Clair Township, specifically contemplated by the original Agreement between the parties, dated May 7, 2018.

The original agreement outlined the intention of the parties to have automatic renewals to the Agreement Annually unless adjustment to the compensation paid to the RESA is required, then an addendum to this Agreement will be provided, no later than March 1, notifying you of the upcoming increase.

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7. Compensation.

Services and support, performed by RESA shall be at a rate of \$68.00 per hour and the cost of mileage and materials for work performed during the RESA's normal business hours. Work required to be performed outside of RESA's normal business hours may be billed at a rate of \$102.00 per hour to account for overtime. The contracted amount together with any additional charges will be invoiced on a monthly basis, unless the parties agree in writing to a different billing cycle.

All other terms and conditions of the Information Technology Agreement dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of May, 2018 shall Remain in full force and effect.

Ordinance will be going in front of Planning Commission & then in front of the Township Board for approval.
