Pleasure Divisions -Do not cross enter pleasure divisions

<u>Lead line</u> - Both English and Western compete in this division. Children 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted to enter the arena with the competitor if needed. Classes for Lead Line -2, 8, 9, 10, 11

<u>Walk-Halt</u> – Both English and Western compete in this division. Open to riders of ages 11-and over. The purpose of these classes is to transition a rider from lead line, provide classes for riders who are not quite ready to trot or build confidence from a setback. Attendants are permitted to enter the arena with the competitor if needed. *Classes for Division* – 2, 12, 13, 14

<u>Therapeutic Rider</u> – Both English and Western compete in this division. No age restriction for this division. Open to riders who are unable to participate in other divisions without accommodations. Attendants are permitted to enter the arena with the competitor if needed. Classes for Division – 2, 5, 6, 7

Novice Youth Pleasure —Riders age (11-18) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog.

(Walk/Jog/Trot) Classes for Division - 3, 24, 25, 26, 50, 61, 62

<u>Novice Adult Pleasure</u> –Riders age (Over 18) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog. Classes for Division – 3, 27, 28, 29, 50, 61, 62

<u>Masters Pleasure</u> –Riders age (30 and over) (Walk/Jog/Trot) for those not comfortable with riding at lope or canter. Classes for Division – 4, 21, 22, 23, 50, 61, 62

10 and Under Pleasure – (Walk/Trot/Jog) Riders of any seat. Classes for Division – 3, 17, 18, 19, 50, 61, 62

<u>Junior Youth Pleasure</u> – Riders of any seat. Age 14 and under. Gates call will be walk, Trot or Jog, Canter or Lope.

Classes for Division – 3, 33, 34, 35, 51, 61, 62

<u>Senior Youth Pleasure</u> – Riders of any seat. Age 15 - 18. Gates call will be walk, Trot or Jog, Canter or Lope.

Classes for Division – 3, 36, 37, 38, 51, 61, 62

<u>Adult Pleasure</u> – Riders of any seat. Riders age 19 and over. Gates call will be walk, Trot or Jog, Canter or Lope.

Classes for Division - 4, 42, 43, 44, 51, 61, 62

Open divisions – May enter any that are appropriate.

<u>Ranch Horse</u> – Ranch horse classes are designed to show the movement and versatility of the working ranch-style horse. Western Tack and attire. *Classes for Division –45, 46, 47, 48, 61, 62*

Miniature Horse - Open to riders of any age. Classes for Division - 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60

<u>Gymkhana Divisions</u> – This division is open to riders showing any seat. Choose either W/T or Canter division

<u>Trot/Jog Gymkhana</u> - Open to riders who are eligible for 10 & under, Therapeutic or Novice divisions.

Classes for Division – 64, 68, 72, 75, 79 Canter strides will be penalized.

Gymkhana (Canter) – Open to riders who have the ability to canter Classes for Division – 65, 69, 73, 76, 80

<u>Check in:</u> Form two lines on for pre entry & one for day of registration.

Required documentation:

Current Negative Coggins and proof of rabies vaccine -required to be on the show grounds

<u>Proof of membership or Membership application</u> -complete with payment

Horse rider combination number registration -same number for the year and used to track year end points

Horse / rider registration form -Used to track day end division awards and payment.

<u>Individual class</u> -registration slips are required. A full page of class registration slips is provided. To be cut apart at check in.

Day End High Point

Day End High Point Division Awards – Competitors may show in:

One Pleasure division (See choices of Pleasure divisions in the chart above). Note: <u>no</u> cross entering into any other pleasure divisions.

One Gymkhana division (T/Jog or Canter).

Any of the Open divisions (Ranch Horse or Miniature Horse)

Points schedule: 1st Place = 6 points 2nd place = 5 points 3rd place = 4 points 4th place = 3 points 5th Place = 2 points 6th place = 1 point. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through most green ribbons won respectively. Ties in Miniature Horse division will be determined by highest In Hand Trail score. **Day End High Point Division Awards** - The riders or handler with the highest points at the end of the shows will be the division champion. Reserve to the next highest. The selection of division from the first show determines the year end division for the Year-end Member award.

Year-End Member Awards

<u>WRC Year End Member Division Awards</u> – WRC club members are eligible for one pleasure, one gymkhana and any of the appropriate open division awards. The points collected in classes entered in the selected division plus a point for every class entered is included for the divisional awards. <u>Opportunity class</u> points are applied to these awards.

<u>WRC Member Overall Top 10 Year End Awards</u> – WRC club members have an opportunity to collect points for high point overall awards. Every point earned in every class entered in each of the WRC shows plus a point for every class enters on a single horse rider combination.

<u>Membership</u>: Forms can be found on the website and at the show office. Member points are kept on horse rider combination for each show. Points for Member awards count when the membership is submitted. Any points earned prior to submission will not count toward Member high point awards, so be sure to sign up before you show. All awards are given at the year end banquet November 5th, 2016

Entry Fees: Make checks payable to WRC. Any returned check for insufficient funds shall be charged \$30 fee.

Number Fee: All entries will be charged a \$2.00 number fee. A onetime number fee for each horse rider combination will be charged. Points will be tracked with this number. This number will be used for all WRC shows. This fee is not refundable. Rider is responsible for having the number on and for the condition of the number. If lost a replacement fee of \$2 will be charged.

Office Fee: A \$5 Office fee will be charged per horse/rider combination.

Grounds Fee: A \$5 Grounds fee will be applied to each entry except to 2016 WRC members. Proof of membership required. See website for membership information.

Pre-Entry Fee: \$5 per class. Jack pot classes remain \$10 pre or post entry.

Payback 50% of the registration for class will be paid out. 25% to first place, 15% to second Place & 10% to third place

 Post-Entry Fee: \$5 per class. Office opens at 7:30 please allow the office ample time to process entries. Form two lines at registration one line for pre entry, second for day of show entry. Website – www.williamsportridingclub.com for show updates check us out on our website or Facebook.

General Rules

- 1. Signed waivers must be on file with the show secretary prior to schooling. Youth riders must have a signed waiver by parent or legal guardian in order to school or show. Back numbers must be worn at all times. **All ages as of 1/1/16**
- 2. Adding classes must be done a minimum of 2 classes in advance. Add forms must be used.
- 3. No refunds for scratched classes unless illness or injury to rider or equine.
- 4. Gymkhana Attire: Riders must wear long pants, shirt with sleeve (short sleeves acceptable no tank tops) and riding shoe with heel. Show attire is expected for Pleasure divisions. Judge will not disqualify rider for lack of appointments.
- 5. Timed event: Riders must wait until the gate is closed to begin their run.
- 6. Current Negative Coggins and proof of rabies is required be on the show grounds. Once on file no need to resubmit.
- 7. <u>Conduct Expectations of Competitors</u> The WRC Show are meant to be a fun, family oriented and competitive environment for riders to demonstrate their horsemanship skills. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by competitors, trainers, parents and/or spectators. This includes but is not limited to the mishandling of an equine and unacceptable language. If unsportsmanlike conduct is observed, the competitor may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit any and all entry fees. Trainers, parents and spectators displaying such behavior may be asked to vacate the premises.

<u>Cancelation Of Classes</u> – Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, a class may be postponed to a later date or cancelled.
