

AApHC June 13, 2020 Show – Health Guidelines

- Facemasks or face coverings are required for when you are in the building; this includes while you are in the stands watching the show, making entries and/or checking out at the entry table, and at the concession stand.
- Children under 10 years of age are not required to wear a facemask or face covering.
- Facemasks/face coverings are not required while you are riding, outside, at your trailer, or at the stall area.
- Social distancing:
 - You may stay with your family group with whom you arrive, but please maintain at least 6 feet of distance between your group and other groups.
 - When in the stands watching the show, please maintain at least 6 feet of distance between family groups and sit every other row in the bleachers when possible.
 - When in line at the entry table and concession stand, please stand 6 feet apart from the nearest person.
- Entries – the show bill, entry form, AApHC (Arkansas Regional Club) and ApHC (National Club) membership form will be available for download on the website by May 31st: <http://www.arkansasappaloosahorseclub.com/>
 - Everyone is encouraged to fill out your entry form and email to our show secretary, Renea Guinn, at rgnea@yahoo.com before the show. Please include your membership cards, Appaloosa horse registration papers, and entry form when emailing to Renea.
 - We can add and scratch classes easily during the day of the show, but please enter the classes that you think you will show in. You will only be charged for the classes in which you show.
 - Paper entry forms will be available at the show if you're not able to complete beforehand.
 - Appaloosa entries are required to be members of the National ApHC club. Either fill out the membership form or provide proof of membership.
 - Appaloosa and Open Breed entries who want to be eligible for AApHC (regional club) year-end awards, must be members of the AApHC. Either fill out the membership form or provide proof of membership.
- Concession stand – we will have a concession stand, but we will have servers. Self-service will not be allowed. Our servers will be wearing appropriate PPE and will serve all items, including toppings and condiments.
 - Concession stand payments: cash at the concession stand or add concession total to your show bill when checking out.
- Hand Sanitizer Stations will be available at the facility.
- Trail & Ranch Trail Obstacles – we will eliminate any obstacles that will require riders to touch shared surfaces, such as the gate, drag obstacle, mailbox, rope the dummy, etc.
