1. Take a practice ACT. You may use a previous score or take one online, just be sure you time yourself.
2. Attend strategies class, 30 minutes (4-4:30), February 6
3. Attend all the subject-specific courses, offered four days per week (Monday-Thursday) the weeks of February 11, February 18, and February 25 (4-4:45) that your schedule allows.
4. Take one full-length practice test, March 2 (Saturday morning at CMHS; bring a pencil and calculator)
5. One test analysis class, March 6 (4-4:45)
