GENERAL EXPLANATION: The Michigan Constitution provides for the assessment of all real and tangible personal property not exempted by law. Tangible personal property is defined as tangible property that is not real estate. Form L-4175 is used for the purpose of obtaining a statement of assessable personal property for use in making a personal property assessment. Michigan law provides that the assessor must send Form L-4175 to any person or entity that may possess assessable personal property. Michigan law also provides that a person or entity receiving Form L-4175 must complete it and return it to the assessor by the statutory due date, even if they have no assessable property to report. If you had assessable personal property in your possession on December 31, you must submit a completed Form L-4175 to the assessor of the community where the property is located by the statutory due date, even if the assessor does not send you a form to complete.
