

WINTER POLICIES

1. <u>NEVER LEAVE FUEL PUMPS UNATTENDED WHILE FUELING, NOT EVEN SITTING IN TRUCK!!!</u> (PUMPS SOMETIMES STICK IN THE WINTER CAUSING OVERFLOWS)

- 2. You must unhook from <u>ALL</u> trailers. <u>DROP ALL TRAILERS AT 21ST ST.</u>
- 3. When dropping trailers at 21st St., do not back up all the way to the snow piles.
- 4. You must give yourself plenty of time to make sure your truck starts and gets warmed up. Truck must warm up a **MINIMUM** of **30 minutes.**
- 5. You must top off whenever you are in the yard. There is no need for fuel additive when you fuel in the yard. It is already treated.
- 6. OTR Drivers need to get fuel conditioner from Dave.
- 7. If you are parking your truck, do not fill your tanks completely full- we need room to add winter thaw in the tank if fuel is gelled.
- 8. **<u>DO NOT</u>** plug truck in unless authorized by Dispatch or Maintenance.
- 9. The <u>HOOKED LOT</u> will be used for trailers with <u>WORK ORDERS ONLY!</u> <u>NO TRAILERS BEHIND</u> <u>SHOP!</u> <u>NO LOADED TRAILERS ACROSS STREET!</u>
- 10. All trucks must face in the direction of the railroad tracks. Park in a single file line when parking your truck, park as close to the next truck as possible. **DO NOT DOUBLE STACK TRUCKS!**
- When parking your personal vehicle, make sure you park as close to the next vehicle as possible so that optimum space is used. <u>THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTLEY NO PARKING ACROSS 9TH AVE.</u> If you have any questions, ask Jamie or Dave.
