





November 22, 2015 Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe John 18:33-37

Pilate said to him, "Then you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say I am a king."

That exchange between Pilate, the governor of the Roman Empire in Palestine, and Jesus, a innocent man delivered to Pilate in chains by the Jewish leaders of his day, seems rather surreal. Pilate knew the charge that Jesus had claimed to be a king was not true. But Pilate could not conceive of a kingdom not of this world, and Jesus was the King of just such a Kingdom. Pilate only knew of a kingdom of man-made law enforced by tyranny and brutality. Jesus was the herald of a Kingdom of Love. Can there be an example of the extreme differences between a kingdom made by man without God and a Kingdom created for man by God? What is our kingdom? Is it a political system constructed by man; a company we helped to build or are dependent upon; a social group; an athletic team or our family? To the extent that such kingdoms help us to attain the Kingdom of God, they are good. To the extent that such kingdoms lead us away from the God's Kingdom, they are not good for us.
