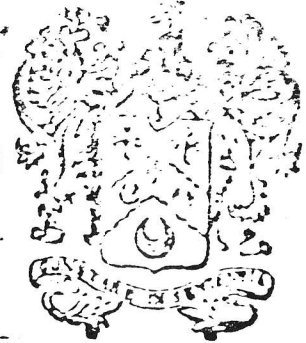


William Williamson eldest son of John & Mary Williamson

 Married to W. P. H. Lewis only son of the Rev<sup>d</sup> W. B. Lewis British  
 Chaplain of Smyrna civility and the British Consul at Smyrna in the  
 4<sup>th</sup> year of Oct. 1851 and enthusiastically by the Rev<sup>d</sup> S. W. Miller Missionary  
 of the Church Missionary Society & the High School of Smyrna British  
 Chaplain at All Saints Church Boudjak on the 9<sup>th</sup> of October 1851
