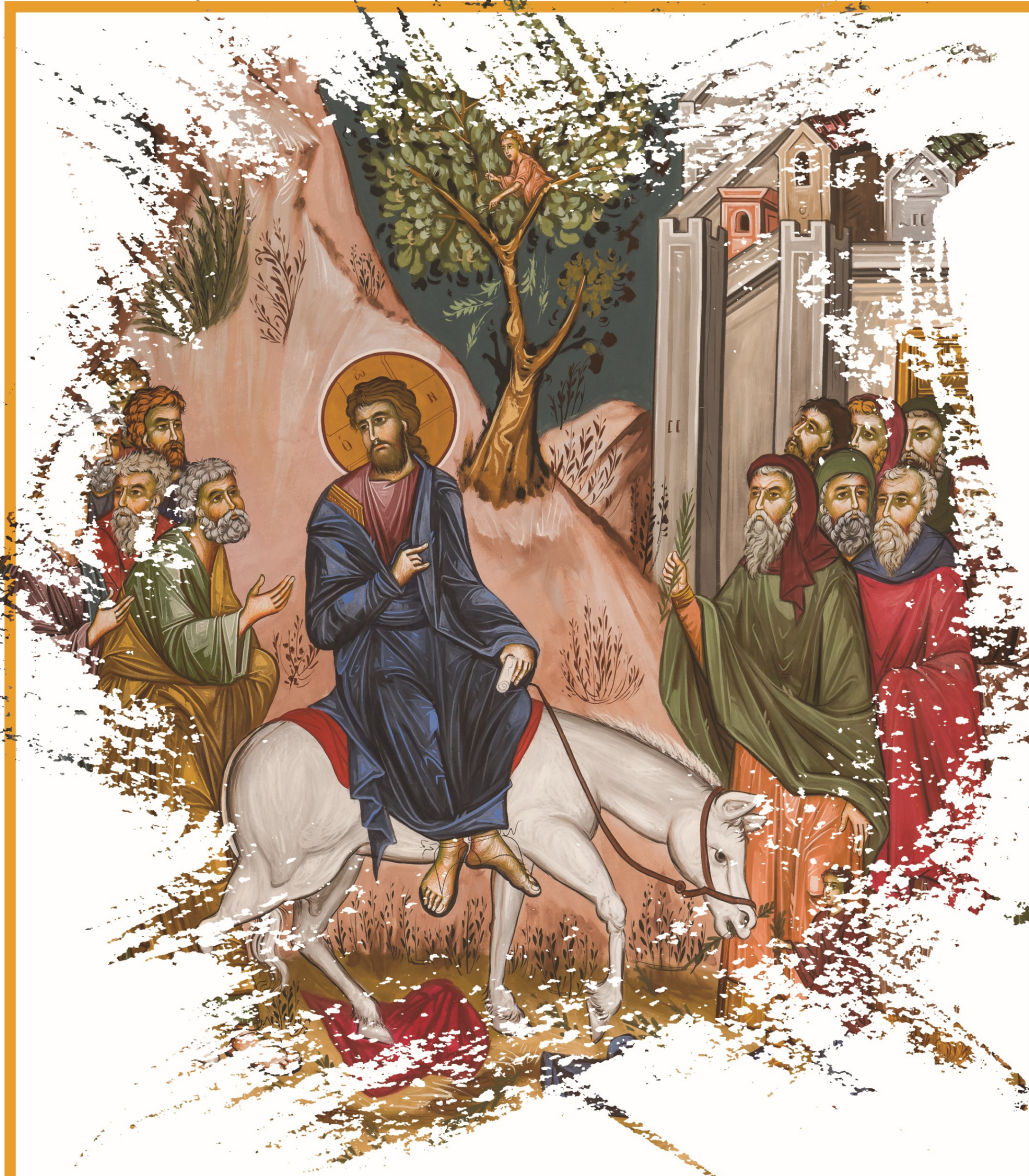

Palm Sunday

We begin this week with Palm Sunday, commemorating the day of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. At the beginning we acclaim Jesus as our savior and Messiah, but with the Passion reading we place ourselves as

sinners in need of God's salvation. So what can you do with the palms you received after mass? Many like to weave the palm into a cross. An old Italian tradition is to present the palm to someone you have wronged as a sign of reconciliation as well.

The Easter Triduum recalls Jesus' Last Supper (Holy Thursday), Crucifixion and Death (Good Friday), and his Resurrection (The Easter Vigil & Easter day). Families in Faith

This week our 1st Communion class learned about *receiving*. The children learned about the Communion Rite and how to receive the host. The children learned about the Early Christians and how they gathered in each other's homes to celebrate and receive the Eucharist (Acts 2:42-47). They learned how we say the Lord's Prayer and give the sign of peace. After receiving communion we should return to our seats and pray, praying in silence about what we just received. Talk to your children this week about praying after communion and what we can say in our prayers.

Continue to use the flash cards given out previously to help your child learn about the different objects in the church. Encourage them to be engaged by being engaged yourself, and ask them questions about the Mass afterwards. Through everyday actions and conversations you as the domestic church are able to teach and pass on the faith to your child, do not be discouraged!
