## **Training Equipment Needed For Course**

- 6' leash (not retractable)
- Flat collar or harness (no prong collars, choke chains, shock collars, or face leads allowed)
- A variety of your dog's favorite soft treats (lots! cut up into very small pieces in a treat holder you can hook onto your clothes)
- Crate (Dogs work one at a time, and must be capable of handling confinement, being crated in class and away from their handlers)
