Eureka Springs Historical Museum

The Historical Museum houses a variety of exhibits preserving the history and cultural arts of Eureka Springs.

Eureka Springs Mural

Main St. Historic 12 by 55 foot mural depicting early days of Eureka Springs. Designed by acclaimed artist & muralist Louis Freund, and painted by members of the Eureka Springs Guild of Artist and Crafts people.

Eureka Springs Interactive Music Park

North Main St. Outdoor interactive musical instrument sculptures; 28 foot wind chime arbor, gong, rhythm, xylophone sculptures. Stage, rest rooms, picnic area and free parking.

Historic District

Two square miles of city included in the National Register of Historic Places featuring Victorian architecture, stone walls, springs, and parks. Many walking paths in district.

The UP Project

North Main up to Center Street, Colorful art stairs mural designed by the Eureka Springs High School Art Club and renown muralist, Doug Meyerscough.

Sculpture, Public Art & Art Wall

Various locations throughout the city display stone carvings, sculptures and yard art.

Thorncrown Chapel

HWY 62 West, Chapel famed for architecture, designed by world renowned architect E. Fay Jones. Thorncrown was listed fourth on the AIA's top ten buildings of the 20th century.

Eureka Springs Native Plant Garden

One North Main, Outdoor gallery consisting of more than two dozen, large murals designed by local, student and visiting artists and photographers. "Spirit of Eureka" history panels.


