Pasadena Playhouse Corn Pudding

2 packages of Jiffy Corn Muffin Mix (8 1/2 oz)
2 cans of Cream Corn (14 oz cans)
2 cans of Corn with liquid (14 oz cans)
2 cups of Sour Cream
2 cubes of Butter

- Set oven at 350 degrees
- Butter or spray a casserole dish
- Place the contents of the Corn Muffin Mix in a bowl. Add the remaining ingredients. Mix well.
- Pour into the casserole dish. Bake for about an hour. Check center to make sure the dish is fully cooked. It may need a few more minutes so check with a toothpick. Serve hot.

Will feed 12-16 and of course you could double the recipe for a larger crowd.

Try adding mild diced green chilies for a Mexican twist or add Swiss cheese if you'd like.

Note: By <u>far</u>, the dish that is the biggest hit and most requested is a simple corn pudding recipe. We had a stage manager once say that she will work <u>anytime</u> for the Playhouse as long as the *Friends* continue to make their corn pudding! What is great about it (besides how easy it is and how great it tastes) is that it goes so well with just about anything from a ham dinner, Mexican food, chicken, fish, or beef. It is a nice way to make an entree "stretch".
