

Chief Dr. I. Carlton Faulk- Bishop W. E. Lockett Memorial Scholarship

Eleventh Episcopal District Awardee

The first recipient of the Chief Dr. I. Carlton Faulk-Bishop W. E. Lockett Memorial Scholarship (\$300) for East Africa, where the Presiding Prelate is Bishop Ronald L. Cunningham, was awarded to **Emmanuel Baraka Kabaye**. Emmanuel is a young anointed 24 year old minister who we met during our first visit to the Eleventh Episcopal District in 2011. Imo Jackson Caleb** of Ikot Idim CME Church in the Southern Region of Nigeria and **Rev Aniekan A. Nnah** of Ikot Udo CMEC, in the Western Region of Nigeria will receive \$100 each. The third awardee will be selected from one of the Annual Conferences that is yet to be held. All awardees will attend Breeding/Montgomery CME Bible College in Ikot Ekpene.
