\$15,548.81 of this balance is funds designated for flowers, Library, building use, etc. This leaves an operating balance of \$12,122.04. All salaries and invoices are paid to date as of April 15th. As per the Finance Committee recommendation, we are paying \$1,000.00 per month toward Conference Apportionments and \$100.00 per month toward District Apportionments. Invoices and salaries continue to be paid as we have the funds to do so. Utilities are being paid first, then salaries and then other invoices as funds become available.
