### **This Day In History**

February 3: On this day in history in 1870, the Fifteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution was ratified which prohibits the government from denying a citizen the right to vote based on that citizen's "race, color, or previous condition of servitude." This was a fundamental step in the future of politics.

February 4: On this day in 1933 Franklin Delano Roosevelt was inaugurated. Elected first during the Great Depression, Roosevelt would go on to be elected an unprecedented four times as President prompting the ratification of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Amendment.

February 5: On this day in 2008, the worst tornadoes in over two decades struck five states in the south such as Tennessee, Kentucky, Mississippi, Arkansas, and Alabama. The worst-hit was in Tennessee with 30 people dead.

February 6: On February 6, 1943: Frank Sinatra makes his singing debut on the popular radio show "Your Hit Parade." He eventually becomes one of the most respected vocalists of all time. For more information, ask Mr. Lerchie: He was probably alive then.

February 8: On this day in 1876, 29-year-old Alexander Graham Bell receives a patent for his revolutionary new invention—the telephone. Bell would later develop the American Telephone and Telegraph Company (AT&T)
