A Note from Rick: Markets were steady to slightly stronger across the board at TLA this week. The hay market was tested with nice, new first cutting hay and it sold for \$140 to \$200/ton. The awesome weather we've had over the last couple weeks has given everyone a chance to put up excellent first cutting hay and we will all benefit from that over the next year. Dairy cattle prices- fresh cows, springers & replacement heifers- showed a bit of strength. Prices were slightly stronger, but the interest and activity in this market is considerably stronger. With milk futures looking much better and cattle numbers that are for sale shrinking, I look for this market to continue to strengthen. Calf prices are unchanged with the majority of good bull calves ranging from \$1 to \$1.30 and heifer calves from \$40 to \$60. The slaughter market remains steady with the exception of colored fats. Colored cattle continue to struggle, but Holstein steers and cows seem to be steady to slightly stronger. It's been a busy stretch at TLA and all in all, things have went very well. Looking forward to the J&S Pony and Riding Horse three day auction this Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Hope to see you at TLA!
