To the Sherburn and Welcome City Councils,

The department logged 134 calls for service in the month of September. This brings the total for the year to 1,117 as of September 30. The total calls for service is up over the last two years for the same reporting period and I expect that we will set a new record for calls this year.

The average response time during the month of September was 6 minutes and 15 seconds. This is a satisfactory response time considering the distance that we cover between the two communities. The increase in calls makes the number more accurate than it has been in the last few months.

I have attached a data sheet from the Radar Recorder that was used last month. This device logs the speed of every vehicle that travels past it and calculates the data to let us know if there is an enforcement issue that needs to be addressed in the area. The sheet that I attached was from data collected on Third Street in Sherburn over a two week period. We have received many complaints over the years about the speed of traffic on that street; however, as you can see there is a very minimal speed issue. We will be putting this device up in various areas around the two communities. If you know of somewhere that you would like the device placed, please let me know.



Total Percentage of Enforceable Violations




