2019 CSA Program

What is a CSA?

CSA stands for community supported agriculture. It is similar to the idea of buying your ski season pass in July for the coming season, whether or not is snows. In a CSA program you as a "Member" purchase a share of Jilllybeans Farmstand harvest of the coming season prior to the growing season, and then come to the stand once a week to pick up your "Share" of that day's pickings.

What makes the CSA?

Upon becoming a "Member" at Jillybeans we all take on the risks of farming. Not only are their the risks of farming in this lovely New England area but there are many rewards too!

Some risks we take are the unpredictability of the weather, possible natural disasters to our crops, and just the chance the crops may not take and don't grow. Those are only some basic ones us as farmers deal with.

The benefits are much more rewarding than the risks. Upon harvesting the crop yield all depends on the season but we have multiple plantings of each crop to ensure we are able to pick the ones that flourish through the whole season.

What are some of our farming practices?

We believe GMO Free seeds are the only way to go. If a plant is to get a disease or not grow then that's the way it is meant to be. We do use manure and some fertilizer when absolutely necessary.

As a CSA Member what will you recieve?

You will be notified closer to the growing season as to when the 12 weeks of pickups will begin and end for the season.

A box full of produce and fruits from our farm and local fruit farms. Which will vary each week depending upon the days harvest, time of year and weather.

Every member will choose a designated pick up day upon registering; Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. If you do not come on your day or fail to give us 24 Hours Notice as to a change in pick up day you FORFEIT your share that week.

Pickups may ONLY be done on CSA days Wednesday, Thursdays or Fridays between the hours of 2:30pm and 6:00pm.

Every member will have 2 wooden boxes that will be designated to them. (*Pick one up drop one off each week*)
