## Rules

- I. This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades.
- II. The following items will be provided for the student: 1 cupcake, white frosting, 4 primary gel colors, 5 spoons, 6 bowls, 4 piping bags, 3 plastic knives, 1 plate, 4 tips w/ couplers, and an assortment of edible candy and cookies to use in the decorating.
- III. Students may bring other items to decorate, but they must be either edible or secured to the cupcake via toothpick (not provided).
- IV. Cupcakes will be judged on creativity, neatness of work area, and if it is finished in the allotted time.
- V. Cupcakes may not be eaten until after the judging is over. If, for any reason, the judges determine that a cupcake should not be eaten, it will still be eligible for judging, but will not be sent home with the child.
- VI. The Chattahoochee Mountain Fair, the contest coordinator, judges, or anyone else associated with the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair or its associates will hold no responsibility for the cupcakes once the contest is over. Parental discretion in determining the safety of the cupcake is mandatory.
- VII. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VIII. If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, that entry will be removed from the judging and from the display area.
- IX. All entry **forms** must be received by the **Habersham County Extension** Office by September 1, 2021. Forms may be faxed to 706-754-5611. You may mail them to **555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523**. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 27, 2021. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- X. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- XI. Walk-up participants will be allowed if enough materials are available.
- XII. Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 11, 2021. Multiple entries does not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. Walk-up participants will not be reimbursed entry fees.

- XIV. Photos will be taken of the cupcake entries and will be displayed for the remainder of the fair.
- XV. The items used in the contest may come in contact with gluten, tree nuts, wheat, milk, soy, eggs, artificial dyes, and /or other allergens.
