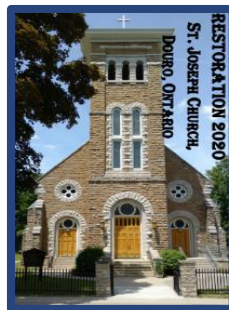

Sany or the Parish office. Sacramental Preparation will start early in the school year. Parnts meting will be on Sept. 16 ath 6:30 pm in the church.

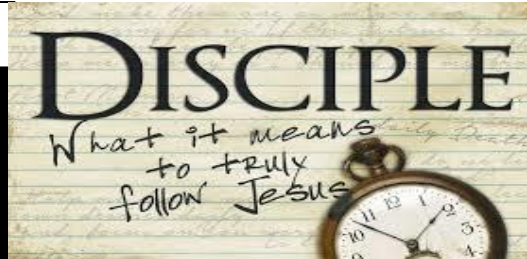
