



Vax-On-Site is a mobile health care clinic **NOT** a pharmacy. When verifying coverage, you must use your health care insurance card **not a prescription drug plan card.**

## **In-Network**

### **Medicare, Aetna, Cigna & Tri Care**

Those who are primarily insured by Medicare will have a red white & blue Medicare card with 11 digits.

Patients with additional private ins company cards like Humana, United Health Care, BCBS, Optum etc. are most likely enrolled in a Medicare Advantage program which fall under the HMO or PPO network guidelines listed below.

*Cards for a Secondary or Supplemental Insurance Plan are not needed for vaccinations.*

**Medicare, PPO, & In-Network HMO Plans** – Flu & Pneumonia (65+) Shots are covered at 100%

**HMO Plan** – Out of network unless Aetna, Cigna or Tri-Care

**HMO plans** - If a patient has an out of network HMO it is the responsibility of the patient or POA to verify preventative care vaccination coverage rendered by an out-of-network provider.
