A. Mr. Dave Wallace, Council Member

B. Chlorine Demand Issues

Mr. Albert is working on preparing a written report of the water test results for the board. He also plans on performing quarterly nitride samples in the future. The Kipker family that farms the surrounding property of the water plant was contacted to see if they had used any manure or applied a nitrogen application to the property. They informed Mr. Albert that they used very little nitrogen and did not spread any manure in the area. The Kipker's will inform the water superintendent if they make any plans of doing so in the future.

C. Lead and Copper Program

Mr. Albert is working on preparing a list of those homes that were built between 1982 and 1987, where copper pipes and lead solder was used.

A. <u>LC Water Pollution SCADA Antenna</u>
