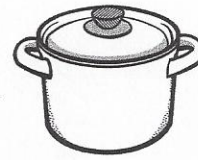

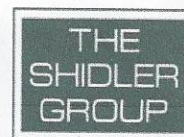
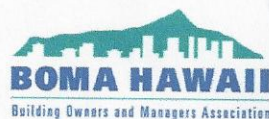
**FOOD REFRESHMENTS TOOLS WILL BE PROVIDED**
