## AN "ELIMINATOR" FORMAT

## Revised: 6.2.18

## Qualifying Round

1. Each individual on a team will bowl 5 games of regular, 10-pin bowling.
2. The 5 -game series scores of each team member will be added together to determine the team score.
3. Based on the team score, $50 \%$ of the teams in each division will advance to the Quarter Final Round. Scores from the Qualifying Round will be dropped.

## Quarter Final Round *

Quarter Final Round teams will bowl two (2) games using the Baker* format (see below). A team's 2 game series score in this round will determine advancing teams.

## Semi-Final Round *

Semi Final Round teams will bowl two (2) games using the Baker* format (see below). A team's 2 game series score in this round will determine advancing teams.

## Championship Round *

Championship Round teams will bowl two (2) games using the Baker* format (see below).

* The exact number of teams advancing to the Quarter, Semi, and Championship Rounds will be determined on site based on the number of teams entered in each division and will be announced at the tournament. Some divisions (based on division population) may have fewer post-Qualifying Rounds than listed above.


## Baker game procedure

1. All Baker games will be bowled on a single lane by each team.
2. Teams will bowl 1-game on a lane and then switch to the other lane on the same pair for their $2^{\text {nd }}$ game in a series.
3. In all Baker games, the junior bowler will bowl the even number frames $(2,4,6,8,10)$ and the adult bowler will bowl the odd numbered frames (1,3,5,7,9).

All ties for advancing positions in any Baker round will be broken by a $9^{\text {th }} / 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off. The adult will bowl the $9^{\text {th }}$ frame and the junior bowler will bowl the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame. In the $9^{\text {th }} / 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off the higher seed may choose their starting lane on a pair selected by the tournament manager and the lower seed will choose who bowls the $9^{\text {th }}$ frame $1^{\text {st }}$. There will be no practice balls allowed prior to the $9^{\text {th }} / 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off even if the teams bowl on a different pair.
