

HSA School System

Each school year is divided into four parts.

Term 1 – September to November

Term 2 – December to March

Term 3 – March to June

Term 4 (Optional: Summer School) – July and August

In each term, students have the opportunity to take a minimum of 2 courses to obtain 2 credits, with the option to gain 2 Arts credits, for a maximum 8 credits per year.

1-Term Course	150 mins/day x 44 days = 6,600 mins (110 hrs)	Academic Credits
3-Term Course	180 mins/day x 37 days = 6,660 mins (111 hrs)	Arts Credits

Reporting Periods

Final examinations take place at the end of each term. During the year, parents or guardians will receive three or four formal progress reports once during the middle of the term and three or four final reports at the end of term. Parents should feel free to contact the school at any time for an update on their students' progress.

Additional features to the HSA program:

- Students are required to join the Daily Devotions time
- HSA offers an IELTS Preparation Program for grade 11 & 12 students
- HSA supports students who participate in Math Contest
