The Four Questions of the Extracurricular Participant

1. Did I fail any classes for the six weeks?

Answer: No. Then student can continue to participate.

Yes. Then go to question #2.

2. When do I become ineligible?

Answer: The failing student becomes ineligible at 3:45 pm seven

calendar days from the day the six weeks ended.

3. What do I have to do to become eligible?

Answer: The ineligible student must be passing all classes on the

day ending the three week period (snapshot date).

4. When would I be eligible?

Answer: If student is passing all classes on the specified mid

six weeks date, then that student becomes eligible seven

calendar days from that date.
