Message from the Elders

We will be having a morning worship service only this Sunday at 10:30 AM. The service will be live streamed on Facebook and the outdoor speakers will be set up for those who chose to stay in their cars. Travis Terrell will be our speaker for Sunday, June 28th. John Dale will be our speaker for Sunday, July 5th. As we announced Sunday, beginning July 12th, Jason Jackson has agreed to teach class and preach for us each Sunday morning until we are able to find a minister. We are so thankful for his willingness to help us during this time and are looking forward to him being here on a more continual basis.

Beginning with the July 5th services, we are continuing to plan towards having Bible school classes on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights. We are planning on having classes for the children as well as an adult class in the auditorium. We want everyone to feel safe during this time, and will continue to implement the social distancing and other safe practices as necessary.

Continue to remember the restrictions that have been in place as we assemble to worship. Please consider your health and the health of others as you come to worship, particularly those who are in a high risk category, who have an elevated temperature or COVID-19 symptoms. We will continue to practice social distancing as we assemble, maintaining the 6ft distance requirements. As we assemble to worship in the auditorium, we are suggesting that families sit together and maintain a 6ft distance from others around you in the pews. We will continue to use the individually packaged communion which will be available for you to pick up as you enter the auditorium. No trays will be passed during the service. We will continue to have collection plates in the auditorium and foyer area to collect the contribution as you enter or leave the building. If you feel more comfortable with wearing a mask during worship, then please do so. Hand sanitizer and hand washing stations will continue to be made available at the building. We will continue to clean and sanitize the building after each use on Sunday and Wednesday.

We are so appreciative of your continued support and encouragement during this time. Please continue to pray that God will bless the work we do as a congregation at Walnut Grove.
