## NOVEMBER 29, 2018 MEETING MINUTES - Valerie Giramberk

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING
Fountain Hills Unified School District Learning Center
Fountain Hills, AZ 85268
November 29, 2018

#### I. Call to Order

Nancy Ordowski, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm. She thanked current board members, Tim Horn, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice Chair; Richard Rutkowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chair; and Valerie Giramberk, Treasurer, for their service during the last two years. The Chairman then called on Dr. CT Wright to give the invocation, followed by Mark Lewis leading the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **II. Verification of Quorum**

Credentials were closed and preliminary totals were given. The credentials committee reported 188 precinct committeemen in attendance and 87 in attendance by proxy for a total of 275. With quorum established, credentials were reopened for those who were in line at 7:00 pm.

#### **III. Procedures for Meeting**

First Vice Chair, Rich Rutkowski, explained the procedures and logistics for the elections. An error in printing some of the ballots resulted in a sheet with the missing names being handed out.

The order of voting and procedures for floor nominations were also explained. All positions are for a two-year term.

#### **IV. Final Credentials**

Credentials were closed and the final report of 191 precinct committeemen in person and 90 by proxies for a total of 281 was given.

#### V. Report of Nominating Committee

Michael Loverine, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, thanked the committee for their work. He explained the vetting of names and announced that candidates were as balloted.

#### VI. Election of Officers

Chairman – Nancy Ordowski and Chris Brant were on the ballot. There were no nominations from the floor.

1<sup>st</sup> Vice Chair – Sheila Muehling and Rob Swoboda were on the ballot. There were no nominations from the floor.

2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chair – Rich Rutkowski was on the ballot. Jeff Schwartz was nominated from the floor.

Secretary – Michael Auerbach and Korena Byam were on the ballot. There were no nominations from the floor.

Treasurer – Barry Graham was on the ballot. Dennis Weiland was nominated from the floor.

Candidates were allowed to speak for three minutes after which balloting took place.

#### VII. Election of State Committeemen

There were 152 precinct committeemen on the ballot. Nominations were taken from the floor. Once nominations were closed, balloting took place. The District is allotted 107 State Committeemen this election cycle.

#### VIII. Results of Officer Election

Having received the majority of the vote, and in accordance with District 23 Republican Committee Bylaws, the following were elected as officers for a two-year term:

1st Vice Chair - Rob Swoboda

2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chair – Rich Rutkowski

Secretary - Korena Byam

Treasurer – Barry Graham

The newly-elected officers were sworn into office by Mark Lewis.

#### IX. Results of State Committeemen Elections

Rich Rutkowski read the 107 names of the newly elected State Committeemen. The results will be posted to the web site by Saturday, December 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### X. Adjournment

With there being no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 9:46 pm.
