#### **FEATHERS IN THE WIND**

Public broadcasting has been airing programs about Native Americans during the month of November.

One program that was of particular interest to me was about how the government attempted to irradicate native culture by sending them to boarding schools all over the United States, often forcibly. The children's hair was cut into a standard "white" style, they were dressed in uniforms and required to abandon their native language in favor of English, or face punishment. They ate in communal dining halls, were taught rudimentary skills, and rarely were allowed to go home to visit family.

There used to be at least 400 plus native languages and now there are fewer than 200 that are still spoken. What would have happened if, during World War Two, we had not had the Navajo code talkers, who used their native language to send messages in an unbreakable code to aid the war effort?

Why does one group always feel themselves superior to another, and, often, attempt to eliminate it?

For many years, a group from the Amana Church has gone to do work with the Re-Member organization on the Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota. It took me years to realize that this particular group of Native Americans were involved in the massacre at Wounded Knee in 1890, when the army slaughtered innocent women and children.

Today, Iowa has only one resident Native American tribe, the Meskwaki, who have their settlement near Tama. The Meskwaki used to come to the Amanas and harvest tubers from the lotus plants in the lily lake. They also bought blankets and meat and made friends with members of the community. It is an example of a - mostly - positive interaction between the two groups that stands in contrast to much of the checkered history of Native and European relationships.
