

ADMISSION

Most freshman applicants admitted to UT Dallas have qualifications that meet the following criteria:

- Graduate of an accredited high school
- Completion of the full Texas recommended college-track high school curriculum
- An SAT score of 1200 (combined math and critical reading) or higher

A composite ACT score of 26 or greater

A class rank in the top 15% of the high school class

Applicants with test scores or class ranks outside the admission Financial Aid ranges may be eligible for admission on individual review.

Transfer Students:

All transfer applicants must be in good academic standing from the last college attended, regardless of the number of transferrable semester credit hours.

Applicants with 42+ transferrable credit hours must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to qualify for assured admission

Applicants with 30-41 transferrable credit hours must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and completion of the following courses with a B or better to qualify for assured admission: RHET (ENG) 1301 or 1302, college algebra or higher (not trigonometry), a social science core course, and a major-related course (or core lab science if undecided). Note: some majors may require a B or higher in calculus.

Applicants with 29 or fewer transferrable credit hours or who have less than a cumulative GPA of 2.5 will be reviewed for admission.

Comet Connection members with an earned AA/AS degree from a regionally accredited college and a cumulative transfer GPA of at least 2.5 are admissible to the University.

Tuition projections are based on 30 hours (15 hours per semester) beginning fall 2013. Oklahoma residents pursuing their first undergraduate degree pay the Texas resident tuition rate plus \$30 per credit hour.

All incoming freshmen receive the benefit of UT Dallas' Guaranteed Tuition Plan, which allows you to receive a four-year, locked-in rate on up to 15 credit hours per semester utdallas.edu/tuition

Transfer students are considered for scholarship awards based on incoming transfer GPA and/or membership in select organizations, such as Phi Theta Kappa.


