<u>School Portraits</u>: Lifetouch will be taking student portraits on **Wed**, **Sep**. **5**. Students should wear appropriate dress clothes to school that day. Lifetouch portrait package order forms are in your child's yellow folder today. You may send the completed form with your payment on portrait day, or place your order online.
