Vendors will be allowed entrance for setup on Saturday morning at 7:00 and are requested to be completely setup between 8:30 - 9:30 am. Your vendor fee provides for you to remain open until the festival concludes on Saturday at 10:00 PM, however, for the convenience and safety of all festival goers and other vendors, as a condition of acceptance, we require all vendors to remain open until at least 4:30 pm on Saturday.

Please see the following Vendor Application and Vendor Guidelines and if you are still interested, simply print, complete and sign your vendor application and return it with the applicable fee(s) to the address listed, as soon as possible. Please don't delay in returning your application. We would really hate to have to say, "Sorry, but all spaces are taken."

Non Food Vendor Guidelines

- Legibly completed & signed vendor application required by all vendors.
- Money order, cash or certified check for the entire registration amount is due with application form. Certified checks should be made payable to "Boost the 'Boro".
- Please provide a "brief" description of your products, services or information you will be featuring at your booth space.
- Due to the layout of the property, all of the Vendor spots are good spots. You are
 encouraged to make your vendor spot as "eye-catching" as possible and to use your
 imagination!
- All vendor spots are required to have a 10 x 10 pop-up tent. Vendors are responsible for providing tent, table and chair(s) and you must identify yourself on signage. A professionally designed sign is strongly encouraged.
- Due to limited availability (15 sites), power source vendor spots will be available on a "first-come" basis. Vendors needing power services should apply early and indicate as such on your application in comment section of application.
- Small size portable generators may be used and are required to be classified as Super Quiet or Ultra Quiet models. Vendors are responsible for extension cords and should be minimum 100' 10 or 12 gauge.
- The Vendor area will be in the **Bladenboro**, **First Citizens Bank** Parking lots (Front-Back and Sides).
- The Main Vendor area will open on Saturday October 30th, 2021 at 7:00 am for Vendor setup. Cars will be allowed to temporarily enter at the North entrance (front of Bank off MLK Jr. Drive) and depart on the South Side (rear of Bank onto Railroad Street). A member of the Beast Fest Staff will be at the North entrance to assist you. Look for the signs.
- <u>All cars must be removed from the Vendor area by 9:00 am</u>. We will have a designated area for vendor parking that is close to the site on Railroad Street.
- We request you be ready for the public by 9:00 am.
- For the convenience and safety of festival goers and other vendors, all vendors are expected to remain in the area until 4:30 pm on Saturday.
- Flea market or resale type items are not allowed. Pets, exotic animals, firearms or weapons
 are not allowed. Paraphernalia items identified as drug or tobacco related products are not
 allowed.
- Alcohol is not allowed or may not be sold at Beast Fest.
