Minutes of August 13, 2019  
Board Meeting @ Athens Village Hall

The Board met on August 13, 2019 at 5pm at the Village Hall. Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brown, A Quorum was recognized.

The meeting was opened with Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance by Alderman Faulk.

The Floor was opened for any comments: Athens resident Ronnie Liles presented the Board with some concerns he and some other residents have regarding trash and some areas that need to be cleaned up. Also, some concerns with the use of Market St. while the bridge is out on Hwy. 518. The Mayor assured everyone that letters will be sent out to clean up the properties in question and others in the village.

The minutes of the July Board meeting was read: Alderman Faulk made a motion to accept as read and Alderman Smock seconded the motion.

The Financial report was presented to the Board, after discussion report was accepted.

**Old Business:**

Proposed Ordinances No. 2019-02 Ground Water Protection that was presented at the July Board meeting was brought to the floor for a vote: Alderman English made a motion to accept and a motion was seconded by Alderman Smock, it passed with 3-Yeas, 0-Nays, 0-Absent, 0-Abstained.

Update on USDA Grant: Mayor Brown let the Board know that there are some minor issues to be worked out.

**New Business:**

The Board was presented with a proposed revised budget. This revision is due to loss of revenue from Dixie Mart closure.

The Village's CPA Contract for the upcoming year was presented to the board. After review Alderman English made a motion to accept, motion was seconded by Alderman Faulk. It passed with 3-Yeas, 0-Nays, 0-Absent, 0-Abstain.

With no other business on the Agenda the meeting was adjourned by Mayor Brown.
